RELEASE FORM

AGREEMENT AND HOLD HARMLESS. I acknowledge that the rules applicable to this Dressage Competition specified elsewhere in the Competition Prize List have been made available to me and, if applicable, to my child and that I am (we are) familiar with them. I (we) agree that the Show Committee holding this Competition has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the Show Committee shall deem to be sufficient.

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of this Entry and the holding of the Competition and of the opportunity for me (my child) to win prize money, prizes, ribbons or trophies I agree to defend and hold members of the Show Committee, and the horse show officials, the owners, directors, officers and agents of the Competition grounds on which the Competition is to be conducted, and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any such claim, and I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for any claim for loss of my (child's) horse by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the said horse, whether said loss, disappearance, theft or injury be caused or is alleged to be caused by negligence of the Competition Show Committee or any of the other parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I HEREBY ASSUME the sole responsibility for, and agree to defend, indemnify and save the afformentioned parties for damage because of any bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons including myself (my child) or on account of damage to property arising out of, or in consequence of, my (my child's) participation in the Competition, howsoever such injuries, death, or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any other persons.

EQUINE HEALTH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS - NON-HITS EVENTS HITS-on-the-Hudson | Saugerties, New York

Revised as of June 2013

Protecting the health of your horse and other horses at HITS-on-the-Hudson is of the utmost importance to HITS. With this in mind, HITS has implemented Required Biosecurity Measures for all horses attending events held at HITS-on-the-Hudson. Following these requirements will serve to decrease the risk of introduction and/or spread of contagious disease at these events.

Do NOT submit the Event Declaration form on the following page with your entry. Form must be submitted to Show Office upon arrival. UPON ARRIVAL TO HITS-ON-THE-HUDSON, ALL HORSES MUST HAVE AND PROVIDE:

EVENT PARTICIPATION DECLARATION

Signed by the owner/agent/trainer upon arrival verifying that the horse has been healthy with no sign of infectious disease and has not had a fever above 102°F within 72 hours (3 days) of arrival. Required for all horses entering the Show Grounds both Showing and Non-Showing. The Event Participation form must be on file for each event.

PROOF OF VACCINATION

Via a signed statement from the attending veterinarian that the horse has been vaccinated against the following:

Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: Equine Influenza Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: EHV 1 and EHV 4

If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number for that show.

PRESENTATION OF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

These documents must be presented upon entry to the show grounds and copies must be filed in the Show Office before any competition numbers will be issued. The results on all required papers should indicate the horse's registered (show) name.

Any horse not accompanied by these documents will be directed to the Show Veterinarian to obtain the required documents and/or vaccinations, and/or will be placed in quarantined stabling until the proper documents are obtained. Any horse showing signs of fever/illness/stress is subject to examination by Competition Officials and/ or the Show Veterinarian, who may at their sole discretion, place the horse in guarantined stabling or take further action if deemed necessary.
